
# Implementing Caring Contacts for Suicide Prevention in Non-Mental Health Settings



### Promoting the uptake of suicide prevention strategies across VA

The goal of this QUERI-VISN Partnered Implementation Initiative is to implement and evaluate Caring Contacts—an evidence-based suicide prevention intervention—in emergency department and urgent care settings to reach Veterans who may not engage with mental health services. In partnership with the VA Office of Mental Health and Suicide Prevention and 9 VISNs, this initiative has supported **over 80 VA frontline staff** in delivering Caring Contacts to **3,400+ Veterans**.

#### **Implementing Caring Contacts in 23 sites across 9 VISNs**


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
#### Supporting implementation efforts using established strategies

The implementation approach and evaluation are guided by the Integrated Promoting Action on Research Implementation in Health Services (i-PARIHS) framework. Implementation facilitation, an evidence-based implementation strategy, is supporting the uptake of Caring Contacts across VA.

External facilitators are working with site champions at 23 VA Medical Centers across VISNs 5, 6, 9, 10, 12, 16, 19, 22, and 23. Facilitation is being provided in a stepped wedge design to allow all sites to participate, maximize available facilitators, and allow for comparisons.
