The Implementation Facilitation Learning Hub is designed to train implementation practitioners and investigators on the use of **Implementation Facilitation (IF)** to implement effective practices and other clinical innovations.

IF is an implementation strategy informed by the integrated–Promoting Action on Research Implementation in Health Services (i-PARIHS) theoretical framework. It involves **interactive problem-solving and support** which occurs in a context of a recognized need for improvement and supportive interpersonal relationships.
