What We Offer

Leading Healthcare Improvement (LHI) is designed to **train frontline providers and operations staff to implement and sustain change** in health care settings. We employ interactive learning activities to train participants in:

- Leadership
- Healthcare Improvement
- Interprofessional Collaboration
- Interprofessional Teamwork

LHI Features

- Six 90-minute web-based modules delivered over the first five months
- Targeted pre-work readings to be completed before each module
- Novel training tools, templates, and resources integrated into each module
- Virtual mentorship, coaching, and tailored feedback offered throughout the course
- Additional coaching offered three months after course completion

Generate Urgency Learning how to create urgency to address a clinical problem, assess the threats and opportunities of addressing the problem, frame a message, and tell a story. Solve Problem Solving problems by more effectively defining, and analyzing data to show the value of a change to key stakeholders through the use of value propositions.	Celebrate Victories Strategically using Plan-Do-Study-Act cycle to generate short-term wins to maintain support and increase buy-in among stakeholders and team members.	Build Momentum & Embed Change Understanding and analyzing organizational culture to facilitate and build on maintaining and embedding a project change.	Additional Feedback & Coaching Providing individualized guidance and next steps on participants change projects.

- Frontline providers and operations staff overseeing implementation and sustainment of a clinical program or evidence-based practice in a VA health care facility
- Health care teams implementing best practices and leading change in their health systems with previous background in process improvement or quality improvement methods

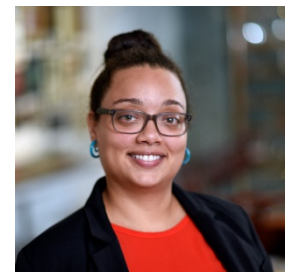
